I return herewith two copies of each of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 27th May 1947, of Midship Section, General Arrangement and Stern frame and rudder in connection with the proposed classification with this Society of the above ship, and have to state that, provided the requirements of the Rules for Vessels Not Built Under Survey be carried out, the scantlings and arrangements as shown on the plans be verified, the number and scantlings of the bulkheads, also the structural arrangements under the bottom forward are satisfactory, then on receipt of a satisfactory report on the completion of the Special Survey, the vessel could be recommended for the class 100A- with freeboard corresponding to a summer moulded draught of 18'-9 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

To enable the Figure '1' to be assigned, the equipment should be as required for the letter 'r' Table 53 of the Rules, or equivalent, and particulars of the equipment on board should be forwarded for consideration.

The remaining copy of each of the plans is being retained for record.
