Further to my letter of the 23rd April last, the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle upon Tyne have now reported on the General Examination which was carried out in April/May.

As a result of the satisfactory nature of this inspection, the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey being postponed until May, 1964.

In the meantime, a fresh record of Dry-docking and notation of Auxiliary Boiler Survey 5,63 have been assigned, and the class of the ship continued subject, inter alia, to the outboard air compressor entablature which was found to be cracked and was repaired by the Metalock process at this time being specially examined by May, 1964.
