In reply to your letter of the 18th April, I am pleased to inform you that provided the requirements of a General Examination of the hull and machinery are completed whilst the ship is in drydock at Middle Docks & Engineering Company, South Shields, the Committee will be prepared to consider the postponement of the Special Survey until some time before the end of May, 1964.

The Continuous Survey of the machinery should be advanced at this time and should include the examination of the port auxiliary dynamo engine, the steering machinery and the evaporator.

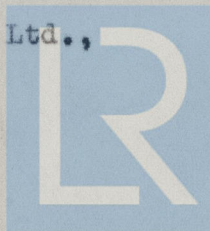
It is concluded that the Auxiliary Boiler Survey, due at the end of January last, will also be dealt with whilst the ship is in drydock at the present time.
