Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant regarding fees to be charged in the case of the m.s. "NASSAU".

The minimum fee for first classification of an existing ship is twice the appropriate Special Survey fee, but in view of the fact that the hull and machinery surveys in this case are not complete, it is considered that you should charge fees as follows:

Hull	£930	(75% of full fee)
Machinery	850	(Approx. 80% of full fee - tw.sc.ship)
Electrical	480	
Freeboard	360	
Screwshafts	<u>160</u>	
	<u>£2,780</u>	

An account for £2. 4. 4d. has been rendered to the Owners in respect of cables sent to Singapore on the 8th August and 17th September and from Singapore on the 18th September.

The balance of the fees outstanding under the first two items should be charged by the port of completion.
