The Owners state that the vessel is laid up but that there is a possibility of obtaining a charter for one year, after which the vessel would be disposed of in all probability, for scrapping. Should the charter materialise, the Owners would wish to carry out Modified Survey for the postponement of S.S. until Nov. 65 and your authorisation to this effect is requested. The auxiliary boiler survey would be carried out at the time of the Hull Survey.
