Reverting to my cablegram of the 21st October, and previous correspondence, I have to inform you that the Reports of the General Examination carried out by the Malta Surveyor between the 27th October and 2nd November, have now received the consideration of the Committee.

In view of the satisfactory nature of this examination, the Committee are agreeable to the completion of the Special Survey being postponed until the end of November 1964.

Fresh records of Docking Survey 11,63 and Screwshaft Examination 10,63 have been assigned.

The Auxiliary Boiler Survey was partly held at that time and to entitle the vessel to a fresh notation of ABS 10,63, the safety valves of both boilers remain to be adjusted under steam.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
