I am advised that the ship will be submitted to a General Examination of the Hull and Machinery in drydock in accordance with Circular 1959 on arrival at Malta shortly, and the Committee are agreeable to this arrangement. The Continuous Survey of the Machinery should be advanced at this time.

With regard to the condition of class requiring the renewal of the sternbush by November 1963, I have to say that the Owners' intentions in this matter have not been stated. The Committee will, however, be prepared to extend the present limit provided that the crack in the bush is now examined and considered by you to be not unduly detrimental to the efficiency of the bush. For your guidance I enclose an extract from a Report on this item by the Society's Surveyors at Marseilles in February last.
