All working parts were examined and found or placed in good order.

The hydraulic cylinders were examined under an oil pressure test of 1750 lbs. per square inch, and found tight and sound under this pressure.

The gear was tested without load and tried over each way by power and by hand, and found to operate satisfactorily.
