I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 22nd ultimo, the contents of which have been noted.

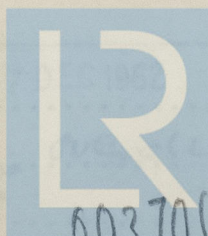
