Motorship "LAURITS SWENSON".

Your cablegram of yesterday's date has received very careful consideration by the Committee today.

The circumstances are, of course, unusual, but the Committee consider that if class is to be maintained until the end of March next, as desired by the Owners, we must at least have an opportunity to make an examination of the ship of sufficient extent to enable you to satisfy yourselves that the vessel is in an efficient condition for the period contemplated. Any certificate issued by you should recommend maintenance of class subject to the vessel being employed solely as a store ship until the Special Survey is completed.

If it is intended to use steam during the period in question, a Donkey Boiler Survey should be held.
