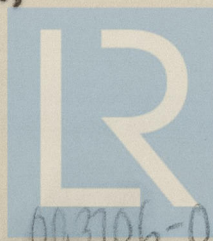
Various adjustments were made, and the alignment of the shaft is now reported to be satisfactory, but it is considered it should be further checked before the end of April next.
