The case of the above named ship has received the consideration of the Committee today, together with your letter of the 11th December.

They have been informed that the major portion of the examination of the double bottom tanks has already received attention for Special Survey, and in the circumstances they will be prepared to agree to some further extension. Bearing in mind the age of the ship, however, they feel that the period of postponement of Special Survey must be dependent on the condition of the ship as found, and that the maximum period should be six months from February next.

The ship was last seen in drydock in February, 1956, and a General Examination in accordance with Circular No. 1959 including drydocking of the ship should be held before February, 1957.

In view of the part of the Special Survey already held, the Owners should appreciate that on ultimate completion of the inspection the date to be assigned will be 2,56.

The Loadline Certificate will expire on the 31st May, and a Loadline Renewal Survey should be held at the same time as the General Examination.

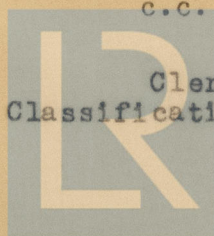
