Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in _____

Since compiling Report C.11 the following amendments have been carried out.

Bridge end - hinged steel door (P. & S.) permanently closed.
Freeboard certificate and copy amended accordingly.

Donkey Boiler Entrances at fore end of casings on upper deck (P. & S.) permanently closed. 4 - 2½" dia. G.N. air pipes 36" high fitted to cofferdam and well aft of deep tanks forward (2 to each) ✓

(NOTE. Airpipes from D.B. tanks situated entirely within machinery space.)

Ventilator fitted (P. & S.) from after accommodation - 7" x 4" G.N. 30" to mouth.

New ventilators and air pipes supplied with canvas covers. ✓

Freeing port and 3 overboard scuppers in tween deck space abreast expansion trunk (P. & S.) plated over and scupper controlled from above upper deck and indicating whether open or closed fitted towards after end of the space (P. & S.)

Ventilator coamings exceeding 36" in height fitted with brackets. ✓

Ventilators on after deck skylights supplied with canvas covers. ✓

18" dia. scuttle on upper deck aft fitted with retaining chain attachment. ✓

Manhole cover on fore hold hatch cover of watertight construction. ✓
