WEAR AND TEAR REPAIRS

1. Shell plating on 1st strake below sheer, starboard side, renewed between frames 19/26 on account general wastage.
2. Shell plating on sheer strake, starboard side in way of aft accommodation, renewed between frames 2/4 on account of local wastage.

Various other minor repairs also effected.

Upon completion all relevant repairs were satisfactorily tested.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with ~~xxxxxx~~ fresh record of dry docking 6/64 now.
