Steamer "QUEENWORTH"

Reverting to your letter of the 16th November, the report of the survey of this ship at North Shields in December has now been before the Committee and as a result of the satisfactory General Examination which was carried out the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey being postponed until October, 1960.

In the meantime, the class has been continued with fresh records of dry docking and Boiler Survey 12.59 subject to:-

1. Wavy bottom shell plates B.6 and 7, C.7, 8 and 9 etc., starboard side from aft.
2. Set up bottom shell plates port and starboard forward.
3. Indented side shell plates E.4 and F.5 starboard side and E.8 and F.10 port side from forward.

all being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the Special Survey.
