Nature of Survey

The Middlesbrough Surveyors report this trawler placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated, steering chains overhauled and minor repairs carried out.

The trawler has been lengthened, by fitting a new fore end, and a new cruiser stern fitted all in accordance with approved plans. fathom

An additional fifteen/length of chain cable has been placed on board as required and verified with certificate of test.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 7,36.
