The above ship has been under survey at this port and has now sailed for Hull for completion.

To complete the electrical survey there remains the following :-

- (a) The 7 Kws. Diesel engine driven generator and the 10 Kws. steam engine driven generator governors to be overhauled, placed in order and tested under load conditions.
- (b) The 5.5 Kws. steam engine driven generator to be dried out (insulation resistance 5000 ohm) and tested for insulation resistance and governor.

Machinery Survey. The LMC Survey (machinery) is complete, subject to

- (1) The boiler starboard saturated safety valve being opened up and examined and all safety valves to be satisfactorily adjusted.
- (2) Windlass steam chest to be further examined, as leakage of steam from the underside of the chest during the steam test was observed.

The Superintendent, Mr. Butler, states that these items will be dealt with on the vessel's arrival at Hull on December 8th, and we shall be glad if you will give this matter your customary attention.
