We beg to inform you that the above named vessel will proceed to the Wallsend Slipway & Engineering Company's shipyard, Wallsend-on-Tyne, on Wednesday next, the 17th August, for the purpose of being converted from coal to oil burning, and we shall be obliged if you will kindly notify your Newcastle office of these arrangements.

During the period the vessel is undergoing conversion we propose to carry out the boiler survey, and it is also intended to renew three boiler furnaces and the plain tubes.

We note the "KINGSTON DIAMOND". is due for Special Survey in February, 1950, but as it is most uneconomical to carry out the survey at that time of the year and in view of the extensive alterations that will be effected during the conversion, we should esteem it a favour if the Special Survey could be postponed until June, 1950.
