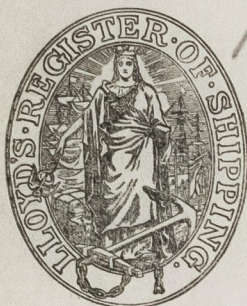

The set comprises :-


Two S.D. Steel Coils, 400 lbs. W.T.
