I have examined the Port and Starboard Boilers internally
and externally except that the lagging was not removed from the
drum. The Boilers were found in a clean condition; all valves
and fittings were carefully inspected and found in good condition and
in good order and efficiently maintained. All safety doors, section
doors and superheaters found in good condition.

On my findings, I am of the opinion that the original
strength of two hundred and thirty pounds per square inch may be
safely carried on the Port and Starboard Boilers. The Boilers
were inspected under steam and safety valves adjusted on 30th
January and 7th February 1947. Fuel oil testillation seen under
normal working condition and found satisfactory.

I recommend that the vessel may remain as classed with
no record of "Boiler Survey January, 1947" noted in Register
