Dear Sir,

I thank you for your letter of the 9th October, about the "ST. BOTOLPH", and assure you that whenever we receive information regarding the breaking up of ships, we inform you of the name and address of the breakers if we are able to obtain this at the time.

I find, however, that even when a decision has been made to sell for breaking up, the actual arrangements are frequently changed at the last minute. In recent weeks here we have been assured in two cases that the vessel was to be broken up at one yard, and then within a fortnight I have been told that the vessel has been sold to another yard.

In the case of the "ST. BOTOLPH" I have learnt this morning that although the vessel is to be broken up at Glasson Dock, it has been sold to Lacmots Ltd., of Sheerness on Sea.
