According to information received in this office, this ship was towed into Fleetwood after sustaining fire damage when off the Irish coast on 25th July, 1963. As nothing further has been heard, please enquire and kindly let me know whether any decision has been made regarding repairs.

ANSWER

Date:— 27th August, 1963.

The fire damage repairs have been put out to tender, and the owners are now waiting to make a decision about the ship. If the lowest tender bid is below the insured value of the vessel, repairs will, of course, be carried out, but if the tenders are too high the owners will consider scrapping and replacing her.
