I duly received your letter of the 19th instant and I note what you say in regard to the Cia.Nav. del Sur and the account for Ch. ~~8474,764~~ you rendered to them on 1st October in respect of a re-classification survey on this vessel.

It is certainly disturbing to learn what a poor prospect you hold out of receiving anything from the bankruptcy in which this company is now involved.

No doubt the vessel will be put up for sale and in this connection I think it well to point out that in view of Section 20 of the Society's Rules it is most unlikely her class will be re-instated if the fees for re-classification are not paid.

You should bring this to the notice of the official now in charge of the company's affairs or any intending purchaser who might make enquiries at your office as to the classification position.
