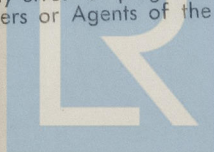

To complete the Special Survey:- The following remains to be attended to: Pumping of all spaces to test; aft deck where repaired to test; aft bulkhead in engine room where repaired to test; shell plate B4 port side from aft to hose test; engine room skylight glasses to renew; skylights to midship accommodation to repair; four frames and one reverse frame in engine room port side to repair. Aft W.T. bulkhead in hold, J. Dobbie Surveyor to Lloyd's Register. holes to seal and test.
