be made in the Register Book in the case of this vessel,

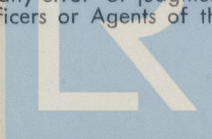
To complete the Survey:- Following items require to be dealt

extinguishers to charge. Governor to fit to starboard dynamo engine.
