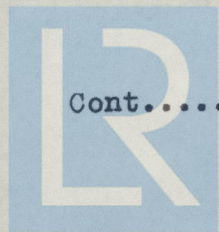

With reference to your letter of the 20th December last, I would inform you that the Main Boiler Survey was commenced at Calcutta in December, by the examination of the boiler mountings and the adjustment of the safety valves of both boilers. To complete this inspection all the remaining items require to be dealt with, and I shall be glad to learn what early and definite arrangements are proposed to be made regarding the completion of this inspection.

At the same time I shall be glad to learn if you are yet in a position to let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made regarding the Special Survey which becomes due at the end of this month.

The Hull class of this vessel is at present subject to set in shell plate G.7 etc (port side from aft) masts and rigging, leaky sounding pipes to Nos.3 & 5 D.B. tanks (starboard side) (cement box) (No.5 D.B. tank not to be used as such until permanently repaired) leaky air pipe in No.2 tween decks (port side) (cement box) and indented and corrugated shell plating (port & starboard) being specially examined
