I have surveyed the above-named ship in accordance with the Rules ~~xxx~~ To ascertain that the vessel is in a fit condition to be towed as a hulk from the River Tyne to Antwerp.

Now examined.

Forecastle spaces upper and lower, forward pumproom, engine room, boiler room above floors after pumproom, accommodation spaces, Decks, etc., casings superstructures, ventilators and air pipes all found satisfactory. The cargo oil tanks being coated with heavy black oil were only examined generally and appear satisfactory.

These spaces as far as could be ascertained, appear to be satisfactory. Ventilators and airpipe closing appliances efficient.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated. I recommend, therefore, that this ship ~~xxxxxx closed with/without fresh record of surveying~~ as far as now seen is in my opinion fit to be towed as a hulk from the River Tyne to Antwerp. The vessel's class being now suspended.
