The British Wheeler Process Co. Limited, of Liverpool, examine the M.V. "TULIPDALE" of Liverpool on the 15th September, 1964 and subsequently, whilst afloat in the River Tyne, to ascertain the condition of the vessel for towage as a hulk from the River Tyne to Antwerp.

Now Examined.

Forecastle spaces upper and lower, forward pumproom, engine room, boiler room above floors, after pumproom, accommodation spaces, decks, casings, superstructures, ventilators and air pipes etc. all found satisfactory. The cargo oil tanks being coated with heavy black oil were only examined generally and appeared satisfactory.

Recommendation.

This vessel, so far as now seen, is in my opinion fit to be towed as a hulk from the River Tyne to Antwerp.

The vessel's class being now suspended.
