Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith the papers in connection with the steamer "FORT BRUNSWICK" and would call your attention to the letter dated 11th May 1944 addressed to the Director of Sea Transport.

Seeing that the first entry report was not to hand when the vessel came under survey in London, and having regard to the leakages they found, the Committee decided in May last not to assign a class until a satisfactory report in completion of the repairs had been received.

She came under survey for this purpose at Newport in August and the deferred reports were sent for the Surveyors' guidance. Apparently, however, they did not call your attention to the case as the Committee considered they should have done so that you might have had an opportunity of joining the examination during hose testing of the shell and weather decks.

I shall, therefore, be glad if you will take the matter up with the Newport Surveyors accordingly.
