In confirmation of my cablegram to you as per copy attached, I have to acquaint you that Shell Tankers Ltd., have notified this Office that they desire to bring certain vessels of their fleet, now laid up, into service as soon as possible for the period of six months.

In reply they have been advised that the Committee consider the time has not yet come when they should relax their normal peace time standards for maintenance of classification. The Committee have therefore asked that the hull of each ship be opened up and examined as for a full Special Survey (C) but in each case the Surveyor is to base his recommendations for repairs on the service in which the ship is to be employed and on a period of six months service as referred to by the Owners.

Provided this be done and a satisfactory report be received the qualification of class at present appearing in the Register Book in most of the cases will be cancelled and a notation of "Mod.S.S. 6-months (with date)" will be entered in the Supplement to the Register Book.

The above ships are to be dealt with at your port and I shall be glad if you will give the cases attention.

As regards the machinery the following should be dealt with :-

- "AGATHA" Examine machinery under working conditions:  
Test pumping arrangements, steering gear and electrical equipment.  
Hold Donkey Boiler Survey.
- "ARMILLA" Hold Modified Machinery Survey including testing of pumping arrangements, steering gear and electrical equipment.  
Hold Donkey Boiler Survey.
