Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant forwarding the Dutch assignment letter for the s.s. "LISETA", and with regard thereto I have to state that as in the case of the sister vessel "LUCITA" British freeboard certificates were issued owing to the urgency of the case. It would appear in the case of the "LISETA" that the Dutch figures were verified, but the English lettering still remains, and I shall be glad if you will advise the Dutch Commission so that if necessary steps may be taken to have the Dutch marking and lettering placed on the vessel's sides at the Port of Registry.
