M. I was duly favoured with your letter of the 14th instant regarding an enquiry received by you from the Anglo Saxon Petroleum Company in respect of the steel twin screw tank steamers 305 x 50 x 15 ft. at present building to their order by the Cantiere Navale Triestino, and in reply to your enquiry I have pleasure in stating as desired that provided the brackets connecting the central bottom transverses to the sloping sides of the tanks be increased 6" in breadth the draught may be increased from 11 ft. to 11'-7½" moulded, the draught being limited to this figure on account of the longitudinal strength of the ship.
