Steamer "MUSHTARI"

The class of the above named ship in the Society's Register Book has been maintained for some time subject to 195 fathoms of chain cable on board being tested in accordance with Rule requirements at the earliest opportunity.

I am informed by the Society's Surveyor at Karachi that there are no facilities for testing chain cable of this size in Karachi, and accordingly I am instructed by the Committee to state that if this matter is not satisfactorily dealt with at a very early date, they will have no alternative but to delete from the vessel's class the figure "1" for equipment.

I shall therefore be glad to learn what arrangements are proposed to be made for the necessary testing to be effected within a very short time, as alternatively the case must be brought before the Committee for the deletion of the figure "1".
