
Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the motorship "ASTORIA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today a report from the Society's Surveyors at Melbourne, from which it appears that the vessel has been examined in dry dock and repairs have been effected on account of damage through heavy weather and striking dock entrance.

The Surveyors report that pitting was found in No. 2 tank, and they recommend the double bottom tanks be examined internally on the vessel's arrival at a home port or before the end of August, 1933; and I may say that the Committee have continued the vessel's class subject to this being done.
