EXTRACT OF LOG

SUNDAY the 7th. of August 1932:

7.15 a.m. Pilot on board. 7.35 a.m. left Yarraville assisted by abovenamed pilot and two tugs destined for Duke & Orr's Amalgamated Drydocks Ltds. Drydock in Melbourne.

At the entrance to the drydock the "Astoria" was carried by the current hard against a corner of the <sup>h</sup>warf and thereby received a sharp dent in plate No.4 range F. 2' x 2' x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
