

The Donkey Boiler examined internally and externally together with safety valves, mountings etc. and now found or placed in good condition.

Now corrosion or grooving noted. The Donkey Boiler subsequently examined under steam and the safety valves adjusted at 180 lb/□", when the valves were opening freely.

The thickness of the compression rings of the safety valves were now noted

as follows:- Pwd. 11.35mm. Aft. 2.25mm.
