In reply to your enquiries contained in the Classing Letter of the 22nd instant, with reference to the M.V. "IMA", Sunderland Report No.30440. we beg to state that the thickness of the poop deck transverse beams abaft the after peak bulkhead as fitted is .40 and that the thickness of the shell bottom strakes C & D is also as approved i.e. .60.

These thicknesses of the poop beams and bottom shell were also fitted in M.V. "MINISTER WEDEL" Sunderland Report No.30427 and we regret that they were given incorrectly on the reports.
