Surveyed the M.V. "RAGNY", 6770 tons gross of Mariehamn, as she lay in dry dock at Kiel on November 6th, 1958, and subsequently, in respect of Docking Survey and on account of Damage 1) stated sustained due to heavy weather on April 1st, 1958, whilst on passage from Batum to Odessa and Damage 2) stated sustained due to grounding on May 18th, 1958, whilst on passage from Helsinki to the Black Sea, and that I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I will Recommend that she be continued as at present classed with fresh record of Docking Survey 11,58 subject to indented shell plates in Nos. G., H., and I. strakes (p.s.f.) and shell plate F.13 from forward(ss) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by next dry docking, subject also to shell plate E.2 (p.s.f.) being examined and dealt with as necessary by next dry docking and subject to poop side plating (s.s.a.) being dealt with as necessary at Special Survey, being fit to carry petroleum in bulk.
