Steamer "RABAU"

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 19th November last respecting the refrigerating machinery and appliances of this vessel and to acquaint you that your remarks have been noted. In addition to the recommendations contained in your report, it will be necessary for a heat balance test to be carried out on the refrigerating installation, in view of the insulation being generally less than that obtained in vessels carrying frozen cargoes.

Subject to the above provisos, and to a satisfactory series of cooling down, heat balance and temperature rise tests being carried out, it is considered that the installation could be accepted for a record of Lloyd's RMC (with date) but without the distinguishing mark 'R', for a temperature of 20°F.

Action in the matter has been deferred pending the receipt of a further report from you in completion of the survey.
