

As in the case of the first vessel of this class, the S.S. "EMPIRE CHIEFTAIN", the working pressure of the main boilers has been increased beyond that originally approved in order that the designed power might be reached. This alteration was approved in an endorsement dated 11. 11. 43.

This vessel's machinery appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed LMC 12.46.
