The Society's Surveyors at Antwerp have reported that this ship was under survey in June/July, when the Special Survey was commenced in drydock.

The Surveyors state that in view of the deterioration of the ship's structure, the Owners decided to have the ship towed to Gdynia, where a decision will be made as to her future.

It is now understood that the vessel is laid up, and having regard to the fact that the Special Survey became due in May last, the Committee, at their meeting today, gave instructions for the class to be qualified with the notation "Laid up - Surveys overdue".
