

This is to Certify that I have surveyed the Port and Stbd. Scotch Donkey Boilers and Machinery of the m.v. "AMSTELSLOT", part 9448 tons gross of Amsterdam, whilst placed in drydock at this port on the 24th June, 1957 and subsequently for Donkey Boiler Survey, Continuous Survey of Engines and Repairs and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all recommendations made by me in connection therewith have been carried out to my satisfaction, and that I have Recommended that the record of Donkey Boiler Survey 7-57 now and Continuous Survey of Engines (with date) be made in the Register Book in the case of this vessel when the survey has been completed.

Auxiliary inboard compressor steam engine.  
Both auxiliary W.T. donkey boilers.  
Port and Starboard Scotch donkey boilers.  
Propellers.
