Dear Sirs,

I return herewith one copy of each of the plans, forwarded with Mr. Jonker's letter of the 12th instant, showing alterations to bulkheads amidships in shelter deck space, shell plating forward, forecastle deck, and alteration to upper tween deck, i.e. shelter deck space, of the Steel Screw Steamers "MADOERA", "MANOERAN" and "MAPIA", and with regard thereto I have to state that the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended on the plans will be approved, provided they be carried out to your satisfaction.

On account of the fitting of a tonnage opening the freeboard will require to be revised, and I shall be glad if you will forward full particulars on Form C.11, for each vessel.

On completion of the alterations the class of the vessels will also require to be amended to 100A1 "With Freeboard", and the record in the Register Book regarding the bulkheads suitably amended.

The duplicate plans are being retained for reference.
