I am in receipt of Mr. Jonker's letter of the 22nd instant enclosing plans (in duplicate) showing alterations to midship bunkers and after deep tanks of the steamers "MADOERA", "MANOERAN" and "MAPIA", and with regard thereto I have to state that the arrangements as shown and amended thereon could be approved, provided they be carried out to your satisfaction, and the requirements of Section 20 of the Rules be complied with where applicable.

I have also to inform you, with regard to the after deep tank, that the requirements set forth in my letter of the 18th May last, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam, respecting the strengthening of the watertight centre line bulkhead in the fore and after deep tanks should be complied with. A copy of this letter is enclosed for your information.
