We request that the Howden Water Tube Boiler numbered as below to be made in W. Armstrong Whitworth & Co by The Howden Boiler & Armaments Co. Govan be Specially Surveyed while building.

We hereby engage to pay Special Survey Fees as follows, viz.:-

For boilers up to 250 Nominal Horse Power, two shillings per Horse Power. For boilers over 250 Nominal Horse Power, two shillings per Horse Power for the first 250 Horse Power and one shilling per Horse Power above 250. The Nominal Horse Power to be reckoned at 15 square feet of heating surface. No fee to be less than £4 4s.

MEM.—In exceptional cases an additional charge will be made according to the services performed, and in all cases where travelling expenses are incurred by the Surveyors in connexion with the above services, they are to be defrayed by the parties interested.
