



With further reference to my letter of to-day's date and telegram regarding the m.s. "MADOERA" I have to inform you that the Owners have also decided to convert their m.s. "MANOERAN" for deeper loading during her stay at Calcutta, which is arranged to take place from the 10th Of December next until the 23rd of December '39 and they will be very pleased if you will instruct the Surveyor at that Port to deal with the freeboard as in the case of the "MADOERA".

We have also consulted the Dutch Authorities in connexion therewith and they have agreed to issue the Dutch assignment letter for this vessel, which has been enclosed herewith.

I shall be very pleased to hear from you as soon as the matter has been dealt with for this vessel in order to obtain the Dutch certificates.
