With reference to the remarks contained in your letter of the 23rd instant, I would inform you that the Surveyors' reports in these cases have been further examined and it is found they stated the tanks mentioned by you were either found or placed in good condition, and it will therefore not be necessary to re-enter these tanks in connection with the items requiring to be examined for assignment of class.

The following deletions are accordingly being made in the list forwarded to you with my letter of the 19th instant, viz:-

"IDOMENEUS" Delete from Section A - Slight pitting in keel and garboard strakes in No.3 D.B. (11,47.)
Slight pitting in keel and garboard strakes in No.8 D.B. (p) (11,47.)

"ORESTES" Delete from Section A - in Nos.1, 2 & 9 D.B. tanks.
