On the 18th instant the Committee had before them a report of survey held at Singapore in August/September last, from which it was noted that the inspection held on that occasion completed the cycle of Continuous Survey of the Oil Engines.

As a result the vessel was assigned a notation of MBS.CS 9,52.

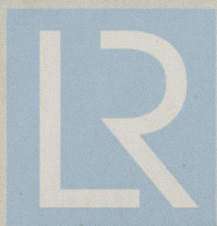
The notation in the Register Book of M.B.S. (Class pending) is therefore being deleted, seeing that the ship is now fully classed, as regards both hull and machinery.
