The fee of £21 for the above is included in the balance of £392.

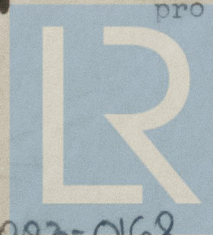
We may add that the cheque received today is for £52.10.0, payment for 10 engines, and this cheque is being forwarded to you attached to Ltr.10., by tonight's mail.
