Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to your report No.18620 on the auxiliary oil engines 169213, 14, 15, 16 made by Messrs.Ruston & Hornsby, Ld., and now fitted on the new Motorship "ISIPINGO", I have to inform you that all the survey fees for classification during construction of the vessel and engines have been received, except the £21 due for the survey of these auxiliaries.

As the non-payment of these fees is holding up the issue of the classification certificates, I shall be glad if you will endeavour to obtain a settlement of this amount without further delay, and advise me in due course what steps Messrs.Ruston & Hornsby propose taking in the matter.

You will at the same time be good enough to let me know whether this fee of £21 is included in the balance of £392 referred to in your letter of the 7th instant, which is due from Messrs.Ruston & Hornsby in respect of engines surveyed at their works.
